Military Hospital Opens for Dogs Wounded in War

SAN ANTONIO. Texas (AP) -- A \$15 million veterinary hospital for four-legged military personnel opened Tuesday at Lackland Air Force Base, offering a long overdue facility that gives advanced medical treatment for combat-wounded

Dogs working for all branches of the military and the Transportation Safety Administration are trained at the base to find explosive devices, drugs, and land mines.

Some 2,500 dogs are working with military units.

Like soldiers and Marines in combat, military dogs suffer from war wounds and routine health issues that need to be treated to ensure they can continue work-

Dogs injured in Iraq or Afghanistan get emergency medical treatment on the battlefield and are flown to Germany for care. If necessary, they'll fly on to San Antonio for more advanced treatment -- much like wounded human personnel.

"We act as the Walter Reed of the veterinary world," said Army Col.

Bob Vogelsang, hospital director, referring to the Washington military medical center that treats troops returning severely wounded from Iraq and Afghani-

The dogs can usually return to combat areas if they recover at the Military Working Dog Center, he said.

> Before the center opened, veterinarians treated and rehabilitated dogs in a cramped building that opened in 1968, when the military trained dogs for work in Vietnam.

The hospital was already overloaded by Sept. 11, 2001, but since then, demand for military working dogs has jumped dramatically.

They're so short on dog breeds such as German Shepherds, Labrador Retrievers and Belgian Malinoises that Lackland officials have begun breeding puppies at the base.

Lackland is training 750 dogs, which is nearly double the number of dogs there before the Sept. 11 attacks, Vogelsang said.

To treat the trainees and injured working dogs, the new hospital has operating rooms, digital radiography, CT scanning equipment, an intensive care unit (Continued on page 11)



Congratulations on earning an award from the Denver Samoyed Association! DSA awards are given to recognize AKC and SCA sanctioned conformation and performance titles earned by club members' dogs. Awards are earned from January to December 31st of each year. The Awards will be a 6 x 8 walnut plaque engraved with your kennel name given only with your first award; a brass hang tag will be given to honor each dog's title. The cost is as follows: DSA and the recipient shall share equally the \$20 cost of the plaque and its engraving (50% each). The hang tag's cost and its engraving shall be paid totally by DSA. Additional hang tags may be purchased (\$3.50 each) by the owner or breeder and paid for at their expense.

You will be notified two weeks prior to the Awards Meeting in December if you owe anything towards the cost of your awards.

PREFIX TITLES

AFC - Amateur Field Trial Chamnoig [Field Trial]

CH - Champion:

Dogs must acquire 15 points, including 2 majors won under different judges and at least one point under a third different judge. [Conformation]

The winner of the annual National Obedience Invitational shall be entitled to be designated National Obedience Champion of _ [National Obedience Invitational]

OTCH - Obedience Trial Cham-

pion: Dog must have won: 100 points;

Dog must receive at least one first place Open B, one first place Utility and a third first place ribbon in either class

First places must be awarded by 3 different judges

Must be at all-breed events One of the required first places may have been won at a Specialty Show. Open B must have 6 in competition

Utility must have 3 in competition [Obedience Trial]

TC - Triple Champion: Any dog that has been awarded the title of Dual Champion (DC) and the title of Obedience Trial

AXP - Agility Excellent 'A' Preferred:

CD - Companion Dog: The letters CD may be added after a dog's name when it has been certified by 3 different judges to have received qualifying scores in Novice classes at 3 licensed or member obedience trials. [Obedience Trial]

CGC - Canine Good Citizenship (certificate)

and rehab rooms with an underwater treadmill and exercise balls, among other features. A behavioral specialist has an office near the lobby.

"This investment made sense ... and somehow, we were able to convince others," said retired

Col. Larry Carpenter, who first heard complaints about the poor facilities in 1994 and later helped to launch the project.

Training a military working dog takes about four months. With demand outstripping the number of dogs available, hospital and veterinary workers were trying to keep them healthy and working as long as possible, Vogelsang said.

Working dogs usually enter training at 1-1/2 to 3-years-old, and most can work until they're about 10, he said.

Then, the military tries to adopt them out and "station them at Fort Living Room," Vogelsang said.


