Motion to Increase DSA Membership Dues Starting in 2020

At the January 2019 Membership meeting, (minutes printed in the March Sam-O-Gram news-letter), the following motion was introduced, seconded and tabled to a later meeting for vote:

Increase DSA membership dues by \$5 to each membership tier except Juniors was discussed. We have not had an increase since 1997.

The club's annual fixed operating expenses are:

\$600 - liability insurance

\$500 - tax preparation fees (Form 990 / 1099s)

\$1100 - total

For 2019, the club took in \$1,065 in membership, broken down in the table below.

The right-most column shows the total income we would receive, \$1,390 with the proposed dues increase. A difference of \$325.
