She keeps pretending she's deaf instead of blind and ignores me when I call her back.

My oldest Samoyed, Teddy, passed away in May. I

still look in his favorite spots thinking I'll see him. Who knows? In a few more years, I might be ready for another Samoyed, but right now I've still got 4 girls who range in age from 9-10 and the little monster Chihuahua, Chuy, that I finally adopted because all the adoption candidates had children in the picture. I'm working on my 176th foster right now, but I don't count dogs as a foster if they spend less than a month with me. There are almost 8 dozen of those now!

I hope all is going well with rescue and with your family.

The family who adopted her lives in Columbus, MT and after getting Jenny they changed her name to Sammy. Sammy was quite sick with kennel cough, not eating and the vet in Columbus thought she might have pneumonia. They eventually had to take her to an emergency clinic in Billings as their vet had not seen such a severe case of kennel cough and several antibiotics he administered were not working. Sammy only weighed 38 lbs and is 21 inches at the withers so she was very thin as you can imagine. This is a great story of endurance and recovery. Lynn said the shelter in Billings is known for having sick animals.

Thanks for asking after Sammy. She is doing very well, with no sign of the kennel cough (except for the vet bill :)). She has put on about 7-10 lbs I would guess, and is looking pretty healthy and quite beautiful, I must say. Everyone who meets her comments on her. Her manners need a little fine tuning. She gets a bit disturbed when she is left alone and tends to dig when alone in the yard, but is getting better. We compounded that just a bit when we had some friends keep her while we traveled to DC for a family wedding for a long weekend. They, however, were very impressed with her and loved her day and night. I'm thinking they might be a great family to take on a rescue Sammy, but need to watch some more. As Sammy gets used to the routine here and the fact that we are home every other day and walk/run/bike her morning and afternoon, she seems to put up with the times she is alone. She is responsive to a half dozen or so commands with no distractions. We will expand that to times when she has moderate distractions in a week or so.

I am most impressed that she has captured our hearts as a family and those of our friends, Sue. My three year old talks about her non-stop for a month now, even to virtual strangers. He adores her and looks for her first thing in the morning, sleepy eyes and pajamas. It is nothing short of amazing, really. My father comments on her sweet disposition and her beautiful white eyelashes. My husband and I love her softness, alertness, eagerness to learn and her love of the kids. We take her to school, work, around town, to the shooting range (she stays in the SUV with at least one of the kids), hiking, to the river, everywhere we go practically. She loves to track deer in the woods. My eight year old reads to her at least weekly for homework assignments. She, in short, has become a part of the family.

I will keep you updated on our girl and hope to send a picture sometime soon. I can't thank you enough for seeing her on the website and linking us up. I fear what could have happened to her had she spent another week in a shelter situation. Our family thanks you from the bottom of our hearts!

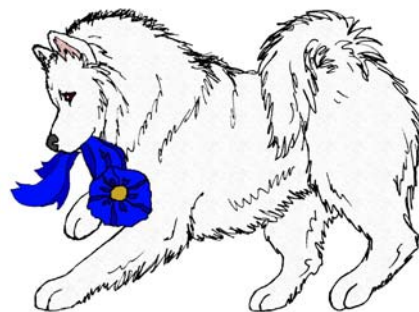
