Treasurer's Report for 2006 - Thalia Peletis

- The 2006 final treasury report has been prepared and it was included in the January 2007 Sam-O-Gram Issue. In addition, it has been mailed to our tax attorney, Ed Sledzik, along with a list of the 2006 Club Officers and Board members to be used to prepare our Federal 990 Tax Return.
- The 2006 year-to-date profit on our grocery certificate fundraiser was a record high: \$3,165! This is partly due to the fact we were able to purchase more certificates in one order and therefore received a higher discount. Thank you to all the members who have supported this great fundraiser.
- I have sent written notification to the bank, insurance company and the Colorado Secretary of State to change the contact for our club to Tom Lisec.
- Tom Lisec has completed and returned the signature documents to the bank (1stBank) and he is now a signer on our

club's bank accounts. I will remain as a signer on the account for backup purposes.

I have prepared several instructional documents for Tom to help transition the Treasurer's office to him as smoothly and easily as possible. Tom and I are scheduled to meet this Wednesday for some onthe-job training. At that time I will give him the Treasurer's books from 2000 to 2006 as well as the book I have started for 2007. He will also have the binder containing all our state and federal paperwork and all tax returns.

I wish Tom much luck in this office. I hope he will find it to be a very interesting position and wonderful learning opportunity. I'd like to thank DSA for all the support and praise you have shown me while I have been in this office. It's been a terrific experience for me.

Local Specialty 2007 - Thalia Peletis:

- Specialty Show contract signed and re-
- The ring rental will be handled by Evergreen Kennel Club, even though that is not how it was written on the contract. Jean Pero, EKC contact, just had not updated the contract, but she verbally confirmed EKC will handle the ring setup and rental fee and to not go directly to Onofrio for this purpose.
- Evergreen Kennel Club decided to not hire the obedience judge after all, so the specialty clubs will need to hire their own judge. We have an opportunity to share an obedience judge with the Bernese Mountain Dog Club and share expenses. Sue Oviatt is the judge they will hire. Breed Education Starts in Elementary School!

Editor's Note: Donna Dannen works at Evergreen Country Day School (ECDS), in Evergreen, CO as an early childhood teacher's aide.

February 3, 2007

Our third grade class at ECDS is studying the book, "Stone Fox". Last week I noticed a photocopy in the machine of the OWS [Organization for the Working Samoyed] site and was very curious. It was the sledding writeup (www.samoyed.org/ows/sledding.html), Anyway, that same day, Angie Studer, our 3rd grade teacher, came by and told me what her class was doing and she wondered if I could bring a dog so the kids could see a Samoyed. I jumped at the chance! I brought a sled and gear as well, along with a couple of my scrapbook pages and some photos I got off the internet of primitive Siberian tribes— some with white dogs, many reindeer, etc. (See pictures on page 7).

There was just enough snow to cover the sidewalk (the playground had so much, a track would have had to been tamped down first), that I was able to make an entrance riding the sled with 'Avie' (CH Tundra Winds' Avalanche Lily WSXM) pulling!! It's downhill to the 3rd-4th grade temporary building. Then, one of the boys rode the sled back to my car, and the kids helped me load up when I was finished. Below are some photos. And yes, this 3rd grade class is very small. Most of our classes are 12-15 kids, but only 7 in this one. Notice the boy Sasha, on the sled (upper right picture). He's the son of retired Colorado Avalanche player, Alexi Goussanov! Sasha could hardly speak English when he first came to ECDS in Kindergarten. Now he sounds like a typical American kid! He was so excited that 'Avie' is a Russian dog!

Siberian Tribes and Their Dogs - A Must-See Website!

Donna Dannen enhanced her sledding demonstration (see page 6) to her elementary school classroom by showing them some of the incredible photography found on the following website. www.arcticphoto.co.uk Although the majority of the pictures that included dogs showed Siberian Huskies, Alaskan Malamutes, and Alaskans, there were several pictures of the Donlan Arctic tribe that featured Samoyeds!

This is a must-see website. You will gain an instant appreciation of how these tribes rely on these working dogs for sledding, herding, and companionship. The pictures are absolutely beautiful of the people, the land-scape, the wildlife, and of course the dogs! I hope you will check it out!

Contained on the website were some brief interesting stories about the people and their lifestyles in the frozen wonderland of Siberia. The story reprinted below is, of course, about the Northern Dogs!

Northern Dogs

This story focuses on the working dogs of the Arctic and the close bond that exists between the dogs and their owners. It's remarkable that huskies can live outdoors in temperatures as low as -50° C and endure severe storms. In North Greenland today good sled dogs are invaluable as they are the only form of winter transport for Inuit hunters. In Siberia, reindeer-breeding peoples like the Nenets and the Dolgans greatly value their herding dogs both as helpers and companions. Apart from describing the lives of these hardy dogs and their owners the story also contains a lot of fascinating anecdotes.

Last Wednesday, Jan. 31, I parted with 'Puckett' CH Mystical's O My Sweet Master CD, U-CD, CGC, TT. He was 12 years and 9-1/2 months old. It was time and I am content. If it's not an improper or inconvenient request, I would so appreciate your forwarding this to the DSA membership and/or putting something in the newsletter for me. He had such support from DSA members.

Puckett's most notable honors were: BIS, 2; BISS, 2; SCA National AOM, 3; Top 10 Samoyed, 2; invited entry to Westminster and Westminster KC AOM, 1; winner of the SCA National Sweepstakes at 18 months.

I have long thought that beautifully bred animals such as Puckett are works of art in their way for their conformation, character, and achievement. But our truest rewards are their love and attention and the joy they bring us in our everyday lives. And friendships we made because of them. That was Puckett to me.

Among the memories I treasure are the graciousness of our competitors in the Breed ring and the marvelous support we always got from those same competitors when we were in Group and Best in Show. I can't think that any dog and handler were ever treated more courteously and kindly.

Puckett was my 70th birthday present to myself. His breeder is Judi Schold. He showed his spirit at 9 weeks by yapping for a thousand miles from eastern Wisconsin to Colorado Springs. Bob Sencenbaugh said he liked to tell people that Puckett was owner-handled by a little old lady--a thought I loved--and a frustrated professional handler once complained to Janet Browning, with whom I'd trained, that the judge "gave it (BOB) to some little old lady." Puckett was The Adventure of My Seventies.

A professional Obedience trainer once told me that in "O My Sweet Master"., I'd given him a name that suggested I wasn't the Alpha owner I ought to be. In reality, I am so proud and happy to have been the Beta (at best) to Puckett's Alpha.

My thanks and love to ever so many who shared my life with Puckett.


