## Diabetes Study

Do you have a Samoyed 7 years old or older that isn't diabetic or have a Samoyed that is diabetic of any age? Your dog can help identify the genetic markers for diabetes in Samoyeds.

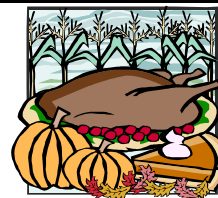
Rebecka S. Hess, DVM, Dip. ACVIM, Senior Lecturer, Internal Medicine at the University of Pennsylvania School of Veterinary Medicine has determined in a previous study that Samoyeds were found to be approximately 12 times more likely to develop diabetes mellitus (DM) than mixed breeds. She is now working to identify the genetic markers for diabetes in Samoyeds.

In her current study, she is looking for diabetic Samoyeds of any age and non-diabetic Samoyeds 7 or older. Participating in the study is a very simple process. Contact Dr. Hess and let her know about your dog, and the name and phone number for your local veterinarian. She will call them and arrange for 15 ml of blood (3 teaspoons) be drawn and shipped to her. Rescue Samoyeds are welcome to participate in this study along with Samoyeds with known pedigrees. If we can help Dr. Hess in her study, and the genetic markers are identified, reputable breeders will have one more tool to use to produce healthy Samoyeds.

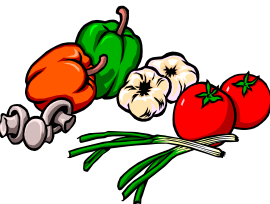
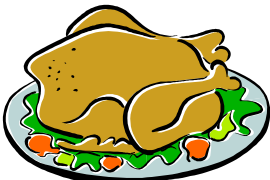

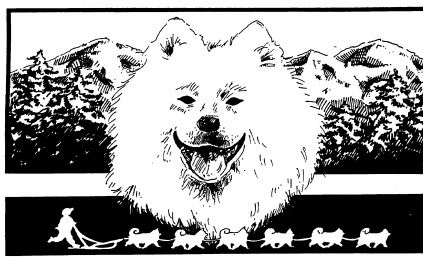

## New Agility Jump Height Policy


Effective January 1, 2001 all dogs competing in Agility will be required to present an official AKC Jump Height Card prior to running in Agility trials. With the end of the year fast approaching, following is an addendum to the General Jump Height Card Policy.

- All dogs competing in AKC Agility must present an official AKC Jump Height Card prior to running in any class. This can be accomplished by:
  - by presenting the official Jump Height Card at the time of check-in, or
  - if allowed by the club, provide the Trial Secretary with a photo copy of the official Jump Height Card with the entry form.
- Each club should specify in their premium list whether they will accept a photo copy of the Jump Height Card to be sent in with an entry form.
- Any dogs that have not been officially measured for a Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by the Judge of record prior to running at each trial.
- The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial (or weekend) only.
- For the Judge's planning purposes, the Trial Secretary should provide the Judge with a list of dogs that will require measuring.
- If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
- All exhibitors should carry the original AKC official Jump Height Card with them to each trial, in order to present the card upon request.
- Misrepresentation of a dog, including altering information on a Jump Height Card, is grounds for misconduct.

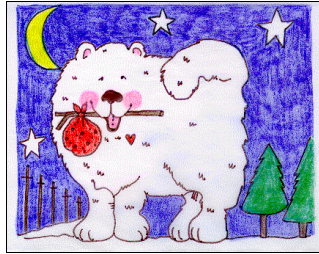
