## Come and Join the Discussion at the October 17 Meeting! Topic: Future DSA Local Specialty Shows

Several members who have participated in the past several DSA Local Specialty Shows, and equally important, members who have volunteered on the Local Specialty Committee, have expressed a change is needed for future Specialties. Multiple reasons were cited by these members which will be discussed under New Business at the October 17th membership meeting. However, one fact stands out - the declining number of entries we have seen over the past few years, culminating with the 2011 Last Specialty having the least amount of entries to date. In addition, the general financial rule of thumb for a Specialty, is that it should attempt to break even. With fewer entries, it makes it very difficult to attain that goal. Based on the member's feedback, some preliminary research was performed, in terms of date and

venue options for future DSA specialties, to determine if

such a change was even viable.

At our October meeting, this feedback and research will be presented, and a discussion held on the general concept of moving the local specialty date, moving the venue and/ or considering holding back-to-back Specialties versus clustering our Specialty with an All-Breed Show. If there is enough interest expressed by the members present at this meeting to modify the logistics of our Local Specialty, a motion will be presented to proceed with these modifications, and task the Local Specialty Committee to work out the arrangements. Members interested in helping with the planning details will be encouraged to volunteer for this committee.

DSA will be in a different ring this year from previous years. Show up as early as possible to get your grooming space. There is no reserved area for DSA only. Randy Roberts is the photographer this year.

Back to discussion about doing a possible standalone specialty and have more freedom and control to make our own decisions.

Jamie will pass on any information or lessons learned from this years Specialty to Nancy Golden who will chair next years Specialty.

Julie reported for Lori Elvera that Lori is willing to pick up the working sweepstakes documents verification for Jamie.

Hospitality for the Specialty - Sterling Clark has volunteered to cover the cost of hospitality for the Specialty. He will also provide pictures to display. We will need at least 3 tables for hospitality. The show will be dedicated to Jane Clark.

Sammy Rescue -Andi Mast

Sue and Thalia reported. The pair of samoyeds reported from last month have been adopted together here in Fruita, CO. Two more dogs have come in from a Missouri puppy mill, a 1 year old and 2 year old. A 5 year old from the same puppy mill will go to a St. Louis rescue, she will need work on socialization. The 1 year old should be any easy placement and the 2 year old needs a little work and will be going to Kansas

Thalia reported the next White Pine order for the National will be going out soon. Vendor booths will all be outside again for this years National. Thalia reported that she has purchased another canopy to protect the booth during sales and overnight as there is no real security at the event to protect against theft, etc. The club's insurance policy could potentially cover the merchandise with a rider policy. Since we are not 501c3 non-profit, supporters can not write-off donations from their taxes, so we rely more heavily on these sales to earn money for rescue and need to protect the investment in merchandise.

If there is anything else from White Pine that you may want please let Thalia know by Sept 1st so that you can save on shipping, etc for those products. DSA Rescue may be the only outfitter at the National this year and may sell additional items such as show leads, etc, as well.

Motion from July Meeting:

The club changes their voting method from the current method to one of popular majority. [Example, when voting on Specialty Judges]. Discussion: Use the same process but the order will be chosen by popular vote.

Discussion. Need to have a better defined procedure for this new voting method and compare it to the Robert's Rules of Order procedure that is used now. Lana volunteered to put together this comparison, with examples, and provide to Thalia to include in the next Sam-O-Gram.

Discussion at August Meeting:

Recapped the suggested voting format which was printed in the Sam-o-Gram Newsletter. Discussion: Thalia mentioned that it needs to be made clear that any change to the voting applies ONLY to voting on judges and does not apply to general yay / nay club voting. Sue asked for clarification on whether or not ballots would be used or raised hands (as it is today). Lana clarified that either can work on the new proposed voting system. The club would need to decide if ballots or raised hands would be used.

The two systems are: 1Repeat Balloting First Past the Post (current process)

Thalia motioned that the club follow the Repeat Balloting procedure for the voting on judges only. Jan seconded this motion. The motion was passed unanimously.

Jan motioned that voting for judges be a ballot and NOT hand raising. Chris seconded the motion. Discussion followed as to why hand raising is not preferred and it was mentioned that there would be less influence with ballots versus hand raising. The motion passed.

Jamie motioned that the ballots should be prepared prior to voting by the President or someone the President assigns. Jan seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

The following motion was tabled at the January meeting:

Motion from January Meeting:

The club donates \$750 towards trophies for 2011.

Discussion at August Meeting: Mary Lloyd was concerned the donation may make it harder to get the additional donations needed to cover the remaining cost.

People could still make donations to have their

name on a particular trophy. Currently there are several trophies still needed and the \$750 would come in handy. If the money is not spent it would be returned to the club. The motion passed unanimously.

#### Additional items:

Peak to Peak is looking for \$145 donation towards the major win trophies for the February 2012 Specialty for Samoyeds.

Mary motioned that the club donate \$145 towards the following trophies:

Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Best of Winners., Winners Dog/Bitch, Reserve Dog/ Bitch, Best Bred by Exhibitor

Lana seconded, the motion passed unanimously.


