The contoured, padded hike belt is wider through the back than the sides, to provide optimum back support and dispersion of force. It features loops to attach a fanny pack, first aid kit or water bottle. It adjusts from 28" to 54" for a great fit during summer hikes or over winter clothing.

Located on each side of the hike belt are 2 welded D-rings to hook each end of the tubular web bungee coupler. The coupler keeps the center of pull where it should be for balance and efficiency. At the middle of the coupler is a welded O-ring to snap one end of the soft, 1" wide tubular web bungee lead. The other end of the lead is then snapped to your dog's collar, or pack. The heavy-duty bungee lead stretches from 5' to 8'. Multiple bungee leads can be hooked to the bungee coupler to hike with more than one dog at a time!

Stem Cell Therapy - Cutting Edge Medical Technology

As most of you know, Dixie has been going through a series of injuries and treatments. Those who saw her at the recent trials said she looked great! In fact, her times were far better than ever!

I wrote a short article that many of you may be interested in reading about stem cell therapy. While the terminology is in lay-mans terms, my vet said it is technically correct.

Considering the feed back I get, I am considering sending it to Clean Run. What do you think?

Stem Cell Therapy

(Cutting Edge Medical Technology)

I was promised two things:

This "will be pricey" and "there are no promises this procedure will work "!!!

Those who know Dixie, realize that she rarely hits bars while running an agility course, but in January she suddenly became consistent at

hitting them. I couldn't figure out what I changed to cause us to be performing so poorly. In January, I took Dixie for a walk after a Standard run and she started limping. I didn't think too much about it since our next trial was a few weeks away and she would have time to rest and heal. Dixie seemed fine after a little time off. However, after one run in February, much to my dismay, the limp returned. I pulled her from future shows until we could figure out what was causing the trauma.

We went to our veterinarian for a checkup several times, but with no diagnosis, we could not start a treatment. It was suggested that we go to a specialist group of vets. These vets wanted to perform exploratory surgery. After serious consideration, we went to a second specialist group for additional opinions. Following numerous tests, all that was concluded was her front joints had mild arthritis and did not flex the full range of motion. She had some damage in her "wrists". Finally, a friend suggested we see a veterinarian specialist, Dr Beth Lewis, who practices "Stem Cell Therapy" in Denver. After much discussion and research, I decided to have this cutting edge treatment performed on Dixie.

What is "stem cell therapy"?

This procedure used Dixie's own fat to obtain adult stem cells, which were then injected into her wrists to stimulate growth of healthy cells. About two tablespoons of fat, was removed from her abdomen and shipped to "Vet-Stem", a company in San Diego, where a centrifuge was used to extract stem cells from the tissue. Within two days, the laboratory isolated the stem cells from the fat and shipped them back to Dr Lewis for injections into Dixie's "wrists".

I learned the cells were not engineered or modified in any way. Also, extra cells were frozen in case re-treatment ever becomes necessary. Stem cells are known for their amazing ability to morph into any kind of tissue, but they do so much more.

"A huge part of what they do is to provide growth factors and chemicals that help the injury heal. It does so by reducing inflammation — they actually block inflammatory molecules. They block scar tissue from forming and recruit in all other kind of healing and stem cells from other places in the body, so they're actually like a master healing cell".

Following the treatment, we had several weeks of very mild activity (leash walking). Each consecutive week, we increased our level of activity that included underwater treadmill exercise. We started swimming, tracking, and finally running. (Shucks, I may even get in shape too!!) Finally, a few weeks ago, we began agility with the bars set low and slowly increased the height of the jumps. From the time we went through the first anesthesia to remove the cells, it took 10 weeks to return to agility. Dr Lewis now wants us to return to a fully active routine.

So far, follow up veterinarian visits has proved that Dixie has pain free motion in her "wrists"! Dixie shows no signs of distress and is enjoying the "zoomies" once again. Those who saw her during the last few trials can confirm that she looked great! J

The next steps are to continue to strengthen Dixie (and Derrell) and to monitor her wrists to confirm that the treatment did actually work.

Thanks for all of you who gave encouragement and expressed concern for Dixie while we were away. Also, thanks for so many of you who watched as she performed her first few runs during the last two trials to ensure she did shine.

If you have ever considered having this procedure to help your dog and want more information, please do not hesitate to contact me or ask at a future trial.
