## 07/18/11 - Membership Meeting

-Meeting was called to order at 07:20 PM by Julie Morris.

-Review of the 01/10/11 membership meeting minutes for corrections. ### -Corresponding Secretary's Report, Michael Prewitt:

DSA received an invitation from Arapahoe KC – Bark in the Park, Meet the Breeds public education event held in Aurora on September 18, 2011

Michael received one other request for a donation, but he had left it at home. He will email the board with the information.

### -Treasurer's Report, Tom Lisec:

General Fund: \$ 10,164.85 (Note: This does not include the \$1000 SCARF donation that was sent after 6/30/11).

Rescue Fund: \$ 22,549.60

Raffle Fund: \$ 11,350.00. YTD Profit from Grocery Certificates was \$1805.

Taxes were prepared on time. Our Tax Attor-

ney, Ed Sledzick, is slowly turning business over to his daughter to reduce his workload.

Tom was asked a couple questions on the grocery cards recently:

- Question #1 – Can King Soopers gift cards be used in all Kroger (parent company) stores like City Market, Fryes, etc? Answer: Not always. There are some City Market locations north of Denver that do not accept these cards. Please ask your Kroger store if they are not named King Soopers to find out if they will accept our King Soopers grocery cards.
- Question #2 – Could we just have our King Soopers store recharge the gift card when it is used up and still give DSA credit. The answer is yes, since the card number has been assigned to DSA, but it will make it impossible for our treasurer to report monthly profit, and year-end profit from this fundraiser. Tom was ok with the way it is now including, mailing cards and providing cards at the meeting. The members present agreed to keep the method for dispersing cards the same.

## Sammy Rescue – Andi Mast

Sue and Thalia reported. We have adopted 12 rescue dogs so far this year. (See July Sam-O-Gram – page 9 - for their pictures and their stories). We have a pair from Seibert, CO, purchased by a woman whose sole purpose was to breed the pair. The girl never took. Since she could not make money on the puppies, she chose to surrender the dogs to rescue. These were AKC registered dogs, whose breeders are not SCA members and who chose not to take the dogs back. They are now 6 and 8 years old. They need to be placed as a pair since the girl is somewhat dependent on the boy. These are very, very sweet dogs, amazing personalities considering they have been living in a kennel that outside of town from where they owner lived. Please spread the word if you know of a family that wants an adult dog and could provide a home to both of them.

Thank you all for supporting our fundraisers. Please continue! We have a healthy bank account, but that can disappear quickly. If you have a litter coming up, or puppy people needing to replace their collars and leashes, please refer them to us.

## Discussion

Many had concerns about the definition of family as stated in the wording.

## Voting Procedures

**Editor's Note:** *The method we have used in the past to vote for our specialty judges has been brought into question. The motion to change our voting procedure has been tabled until the August meeting, when the alternate procedure could be better described. Lana McClellan volunteered to provide the procedure for the alternate method. Thank you Lana for helping with this research.*

**Repeated Balloting method is the alternate method for voting that has been proposed to replace the current method that DSA uses called "First Past the Post".**

### **Wikipedia – Voting methods in deliberative assemblies.**

**Repeated balloting** is a voting system in which a candidate who achieves the voting basis (usually a majority of votes cast) is elected; otherwise, voting is repeated, with no candidates involuntarily eliminated. In legislative and parliamentary procedure, this is usually the default system of voting.

*Robert's Rules of Order* recommends the use of repeated balloting to obtain a majority vote for the winning candidate in elections for officers in which the assembly is physically gathered together.

**First past the post** (abbreviated FPTP or FPP) was coined as an analogy to horse racing, where the winner of the race is the first to pass a particular point (the "post") on the track after which all other runners automatically and completely lose (that is, the payoff is "winner-takes-all"). There is, however, no "post" that the winning candidate must pass in order to win, as the winning candidate is required only to have received the highest number of votes in his or her favor. In a multiple member first-past-the-post ballot, the first candidates in order of highest vote to cross the "line" (that is, those who have the successively greater number of votes) are elected. The most fundamental criticism of FPTP, that a large majority of votes may play no part in determining the outcome. FPTP permits a high level of wasted vote,
