Post-Operative Pain Relief

Easing the Suffering

Sometimes there is no cure. If an animal is injured, for example, its bones cannot be unbroken.

Similarly, a tumor that has developed in a dog's leg cannot magically disappear. To the person who loves that dog, the quality of life takes precedence. Dr. Ann Wagner's study, titled Low-Dose Constant Rate Infusion of Ketamine for Post-Operative Analgesia in Dogs addresses the comfort of dogs after necessary surgery.

Years ago, people commonly disregarded pain and suffering in animals. When an animal underwent surgery, anesthetic was used more to prevent the veterinarian from being bitten than to save the creature from agony. Of course, that is no longer the case.

With the advancement of veterinary science, there is greater concern for an animal's comfort during and after surgery. Surgery for pets, just as for people, is very intricate. No one drug or method can solve every problem or complication. But Dr. Wagner's study, funded by Morris Animal Foundation, has found that low doses of a drug called Ketamine—in conjunction with other pain relievers—can more effectively relieve the pain a dog feels after major surgery, such as the amputation of a leg.

Veterinary surgeons are familiar with Ketamine as an anesthetic, but its application as a pain reliever is just coming to light. Dr. Wagner's study found that the dogs displayed fewer pain-related behavior changes and were somewhat more active with the

addition of Ketamine to the usual post-operative pain relieving drugs.

The veterinarians in this study used the University of Melbourne Pain Scale, which measures such things as heart rate and blood pressure, to determine the amount of pain a dog suffers. Familiarity with the dog's mannerisms enables the pet owner to recognize pain by observing behavioral differences at home.

Sometimes the only solution to a medical problem is surgery, but thanks to Dr. Wagner's work, many dogs will be more comfortable after surgery. When pain is obvious in a dog's eyes, caring means more than curing.

received and deposited
1/1/02-12/12/02 which
represents part of 2002 and
also part of 2003 renewal
year's membership dues.

Some Local Specialty trans-
actions occur in the previous
year of the actual event.
For instance, advertising,
trophy donations, & AKC
recording fees, have already
been processed in 2002 for
the 2003 Specialty. These
transactions were assigned a
budget year equal to the
year the event takes place,
i.e. 2003. This gives us the
ability to provide a break-
down for a particular Spe-
cialty which is a helpful view
to the Committee Chairper-
son when determining a
budget for the next Spe-
cialty.

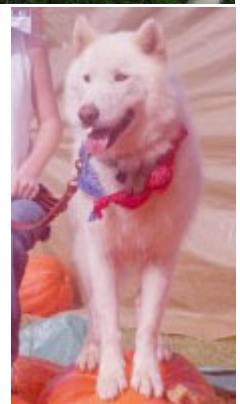
