- How do you feel about hair on your clothing, furniture, etc.?
- Who will feed the dog? What will you feed it?

- · Will the dog be allowed to accompany you on family excursions?
- · Are you away from home during the day? At night?
- · What will you do with a dog when you go on vacation?
- Are you willing to spend time training a dog?

- · What will you do if your dog digs holes in your lawn?
