# **Board Meeting Minutes**

#### 07/16/98 - Board Meeting

Present:

-Meeting was called to order at 07:00 PM by Bob Sencenbaugh.

# -President's Report, Bob Sencenbaugh: 2001 SCA National Specialty:

- Several people who are interested in hosting the 2001 National Specialty in Colorado have approached Bob. It would be Region 5's turn in 2001. Colorado has not hosted the Specialty since 1991, which would make it 10 years. Bob surveyed the other clubs in Region 5 and they are not interested in making a bid.
- The Board decided that this discussion would be brought to the membership in the July membership meeting. A motion will be made on whether DSA will make a bid to host the Specialty. Voting will not occur until the September membership meeting.
- The Reality Check. Hosting a Specialty is extremely time-consuming, requires committed and hard working committee members, requires massive fundraising, and often is the source for personal conflicts amongst club members. DSA experienced this first hand in '91, and some of the personal hardship is still felt by some of the members. Thus, they are leery about the prospect from both a personal and club perspective. Can DSA handle this strain? However, on a positive note, the '91 Specialty was the most financially successful National, primarily because of Colorado's central location, drawing Sammy people from all parts of the country. Therefore, the Board asked Bob to survey past clubs who have hosted the National and ask them a variety of questions, to find out the keys to making the experience a successful venture and a positive experience for the club. The Board felt that with this information, the club members could make an informed decision and understand exactly what they are committing to, should they agree to do it. Bob agreed to have the feedback by the August membership meeting. The survey results will be posted in the Sam-O-Gram, and the discussion in general will be heavily advertised in the newsletter to try to ensure we have as best a representation as possible when we vote on the motion.
- A suggestion was made that should the club decide to host the National, that it would be handled as a professional business project. Meaning, a project plan would be developed, with milestones, tasks, resources and deadlines identified. Bob vowed he would also keep the composure of the members on a professional level as well, to minimize and preferably eliminate the personal conflicts that occurred in the past.

- Weight Pull Clinic. If there is good participation at the July Weight Pull Clinic then Bob plans to hold:
- Another clinic in August. Clinic / Sanctioned Pull in September. Geoff Abbott has already agreed to judge the event, so dogs can earn points to their working title.
- Hip, Chip and Eye Clinic. A survey in the next two club meetings will be taken to determine if there is interest in holding a clinic for hip x-rays, microchip, possible CERF eye exams and others. The survey will include a list of tests and services that could be offered and column to indicate approximately how many dogs they themselves would bring to for that service. If there is interest, then a flyer would be posted in the newsletter and sent to other breed clubs, and a date determined, possibly in October after the National.
- <u>Leftover trophy collars and leads.</u> The Local Specialty has leftover trophy soft slip collars and leads. The proposal by the Board is to sell these items at cost to the members. Items remaining after this offer will be raffled at the December meeting.

In addition, she will send a copy to SCA for their opinions on the topics. If they approve of the material she will forward them to the AKC public education department. They will be also available at the breeder showcase. Also, the board suggested offering the material to other clubs for a nominal fee. 
