Also, the following motion was made and tabled to vote on at the October meeting.

**Motion:** "2001 Nat'l Specialty to be hosted by DSA and Friends". **Motion amended.** 

Amendment: "DSA will release it's name to be used by a committee to submit a bid for the 2001 National Specialty. This group could be named "DSA and Friends". In addition, DSA accepts no financial responsibility nor has oversight over the committee". Motion Passed (8–Y,7–N).

- We are presuming that this group will not jeopardize the club's name or reputation, since many of the committee members will be DSA members. This is an assumption, but obviously not a guarantee.
- We are also assuming this committee will want to be named "DSA and Friends". Nothing forces them to accept this name, other than it would provided name recognition and identify the region of the country this Specialty will be held in.
- DSA may choose to delegate a representative who would attend this committee meeting and report back to DSA on their progress.

me his shop and provided his welding skills to build the cart, and Lorrie McAllister of Chinookwind Outfitters helped organize the clinics, and the Novice pull. She also provided weight pull harnesses for those who did not have them.

The first clinic was held July 18<sup>th</sup>. Due to a hot summer, we found an indoor site at the SkyLab training center. We had 15 dogs at our first clinic. The clinic focused on introducing the dogs to the cart and working light loads, with lots of repetition. The second clinic, in August, was also held at SkyLabs. This time we had 30 Sams and 2 Mals. During the clinic I discussed the IWPA rules, and some training methods to allow you to train at home with minimal equipment. Each dog was able to make 5 pulls with the weight going from 200 lbs to 400 lbs, then back to 200 lbs.

We had planned to then hold our Novice/Amateur weight pull in September, however, there was so much interest that I scheduled another clinic, this one was September 13<sup>th</sup>. Once again we had a great turn out, with some handlers traveling two hours to get to the site. We worked the basic again but managed to increase the weight to almost 600 lbs.


The First Annual DSA Pre National Novice/Amateur Weight Pull was held on September 26<sup>th</sup>. To avoid weather problems (mostly the heat) we held the event indoors at the SkyLabs Training Center. There were 6 Novice entries, 21 Amateur entries and 2 pulling for exhibition only. All but two of these entries were Sams.

The pull chute was uphill, (who knew the floor sloped that much uphill) and a lot of group elected to pull according to



IWPA rules until their last pulls. Special thanks to Gabe Castro, Jane Reller, Deb Sencenbaugh, Michele Schmidt, and Linda Kitzman for their help in putting on this event and the clinics that preceded it.

The whole group pulled really well. There were a lot of excited Sammy and Mal handlers who knew their dogs could really work. Many of them were making plans to pull at the National, and now knew their Sams could really pull.

The site chosen for the weight pull and agility trials at the National were located about ½ mile from the conformation rings in Escondido California. The area was in great shape, the Lawrence Welk Resort staff had done an excellent job in getting this area ready for us. After dragging the cart around the site, I located the best area for the pull chute. The pull would be on grass, a new surface to most of the dogs competing.

John and Kathy Regan had done a wonderful job organizing the event, and working with the Show Committee to insure the pulls would not conflict with other events. Those of you who have pulled at previous Nationals, know just how difficult that can be.

The Novice Clinic was held on Thursday, October 8, 1998, after conformation judging was completed. I started with an introduction to weight pulling. I also had a handout available that included the IWPA (International Weight Pull Association) rules, and some training information. We had a total of 19 Sams entered in the Clinic. Every Sam entered demonstrated he had good reason to be there. They all did very well. As a result the great effort by the entrants, the pull went till well after dark. The pull finally completed by lining up several vehicles and turning on their headlights.

Because it was a clinic we only offered trophies for top weight pulled and top percentage. Those winners were: Top weight pulled - 912 lbs. by Krystall's Treasured Memory "Samson" handled by Mary Lee Lloyd High Percentage - 14.05 x by Abakan Whitestar O'Tundra Winds "Kachina" handled by Ann O'Neil High Percentage by a Veteran - Critza's Sugar and Spice

Special thanks to several people who helped out. Mary Lloyd stayed till well after dark to help put equipment away and Debbi and Kathy worked even later completing paper work and filling out certificates. A total of 8 dogs qualified for working points by pulling 12 times their body weights while following IWPA rules. Our volunteer sled marshal was Michael Lofton. Mike had Border Collies, and was the judge for the Herding Instinct testing conducted earlier in the week. Mike thought that judging Sams would give him something to laugh about later. However Mike was so impressed (all the Sams passed their instinct testing) that he wanted to see them pull. Not being able to just watch he jumped in and helped with the cart. Mike stated that after seeing our Sams work both in herding and now weight pulling, he now has a new respect for the breed, and will not let anyone bad mouth them again.

The Non Sanctioned IWPA Weight Pull was held on Friday, October 9, 1998, once again after conformation judging was completed. John and Kathy had everything ready and were waiting for me when I showed up (sorry guys). All entrants now had to pull according to IWPA sanctioned rules. We had a great group of dogs competing, many with a lot of experience, some newcomers, but all were willing to really pull.

The weight started at 240 lbs and went up by increments of 112 lbs. As the group competed and the weight increased the track started getting rutted. This made the track more difficult and the dogs had to work a lot harder. All the Sams who competed showed a real working attitude, those who did not pull enough weight to earn working points will be able to do it with a little more experience and training. 9 of the competitors did qualify for working points toward their WS or WSX, pulling 12 times their body weight. We had one entry that not only qualified for working points but also earned his WS with this pull. Linda Kitzman's CH Artic Mist's Sound Barrier CD "Chuck" earned 75 points at the pull to exceed the 1,000 points required for his WS. Way to go Linda.




