Treasurer Report, Thalia – Balances as of 12/31/2015: General Fund - \$13,237.98, Rescue Fund - \$27,283.42, Grocery Cards - \$0.00. Grand Total - \$40,521.40

The audit report for 2015 has been completed along with the tax return and required 1099's. All treasury reports located on the website are up-to-date as of 1/9/2016.

Grocery Cards have now been completely switched to the reloadable cards. Happy to report that the club earnings have increased over the last 2 years. 2012 earnings \$3058, 2013 earnings \$2335, 2014 earnings \$2590 and 2015 earnings \$2739.

After reviewing the cash flow reports over the last 4 years, a substantial expense for the club has been the Holiday dinner and Specialty banquet dinners and the costs have continued to increase from year to year. Discussion was had to subsidize the holiday party dinner (Example - \$20 club, \$15 member) and to double the value of the worker card if it is re-

deemed for the Specialty banquet or Holiday Party!

Andi made a motion that the DSA worker card coupon value is worth double when redeemed for the Specialty banquet dinner and the Holiday dinner. Julie seconded the motion. Motion was approved.
