Dear SCA Member:

I have the pleasure and task of organizing the Silent and Live Auctions for our National Specialty to be held this Fall. I have let several ideas percolate through my mind for several months, have talked them up, solicited feedback, and had a few insomniac moments. I have decided to put forth a new idea, one that has to my knowledge not been tried, and to formally issue, and in the spirit of the recent Winter Olympics, to now declare open the '50-State Auction Challenge', with the games to be officially held in Post Falls, Idaho this autumn. Here are the nuts and bolts of this fund-raising proposal.

The SCA membership is being sent, in 50 state block e-mailings, this letter. I would like each state to offer, for auction, a 'Gift Basket', representing the best and most imaginative wares of its individual region. I also want to encourage imaginations to run wild, and for pizzazz, daring, artistry, generosity, spirit, silliness, cleverness to all be characteristics of this challenge, as indeed they are of our membership. And,

certainly, our breed has captured the canine market on silliness and cleverness. What I envision at the National are several tables set aside, with all 50 baskets displayed for a few days, with an individual state flag and name before each one. But here is where the fun begins. In each state, I would like an individual or committee to agree to be captain or chairpersons. This individual or committee would communicate with the members, solicit donations, talk up the concept, and motivate a paradigm shift in the world of gift baskets!! Some examples (these may account for the insomnia): perhaps the folks in Vermont would use as a basket a maple syrup bucket, filled with pancake batter, syrup, scone mix, autumn leaf items such as napkins, placemats, etc. The Montanans might instead fill a creel (fishing basket) with outdoor items to take on a dog-hike or boating trip. The Oregonians might think to use a myrtle wood salad bowl as its basket. What if the LA crowd filled a large popcorn maker with all the great (and not so great) doggie DVD's; Sled Dogs, Eight Below, Air Bud. A Napa picnic from the Northern Californians? The Floridians and Georgians, the Cheeseheads, the Pilgrims, the Crab and Lobster people - you know who you are - and now you get the idea. The richness is overwhelming.

On the third day, GOD created all animals of the earth to serve as food for the Dog.

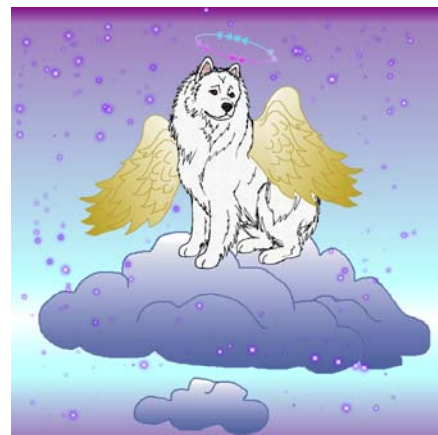
On the fourth day, GOD created honest toil, so that man could labor for the Dog.

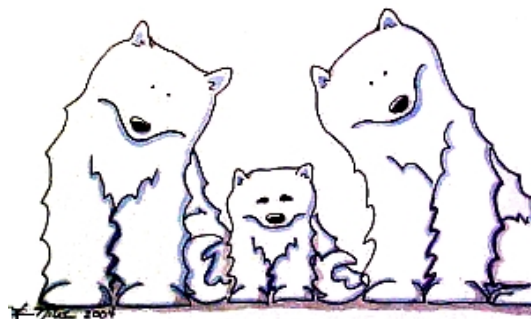

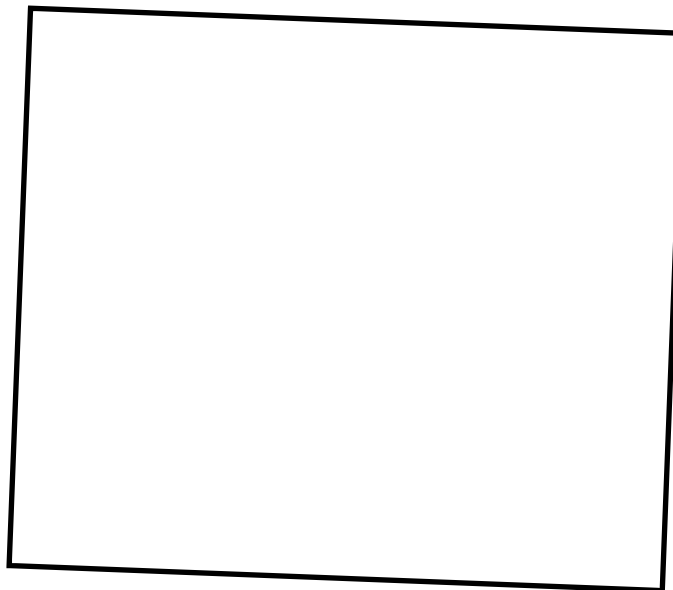

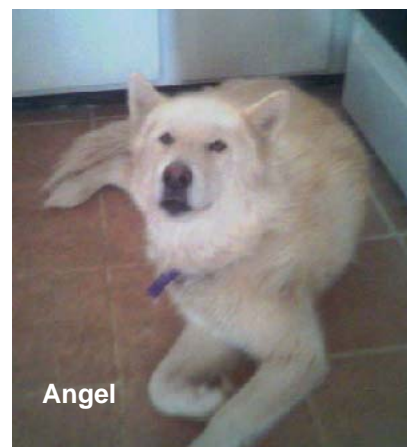
