Dog Rules for Christmas

- Be especially patient with your humans during this time. They may appear to be more stressed out than usual and they will appreciate long comforting dog leans.

- A big man with a white beard and a very loud laugh may emerge from your fireplace in the middle of the night. DON'T BITE HIM!

DSR Memorial



enver Samoyed Rescue is mourning the loss of one of its greatest supporters, Stanley Yellott. Stanley valiantly battled with cancer over the past year until a brain tumor which developed only a couple of weeks ago, took him from us on November 30th

Stanley, and his wife Denice Norby had adopted Tavaresh in November, 1997 from DSR. 'Tovi' as they call him, was a 4-month

old puppy found as a stray in Utah. In addition, they had adopted their other Sammy, Sugar, from another rescue group. Both dogs became registered therapy dogs through Delta Society, and volunteered with Stanley at The Medical Center of Aurora South. Stanley was also a board member of Denver Pet Partners (DPP) and recently became licensed as a Delta Society Pet Partner Evaluator.

Jane Reller remembers, "I first met Stan and Denice when I went to a DPP summer picnic I saw listed on the DPP web page. I wasn't a member of DPP at that time. I saw a couple with Sammies, so naturally went right for them. When they told me their names I recognized them from when I did DSR thank-you cards. We talked for quite a bit.

After that I would see them at DPP events and training sessions. They were always really nice and I could see truly cared about their dogs and helping people.

I will truly miss Stan. He was a great guy."

Thalia Peletis remembers, "I first knew of Stanley through DSR and as Treasurer. He and Denice made monthly donations to our rescue fund in honor of the Sammies they had adopted. On a personal note, I knew Stanley from my involvement with DPP and Delta Society. He was present in the pet partner training workshop I attended where he role-played a hospital patient and he earned

his nickname, 'Staggerin Stan' as he purposely staggered by the dogs using a walker or cane to see how the dogs would react in that situation.

I took such comfort in knowing he was present in the room when Sunny and I were evaluated as a pet partner team for the first time. I was so nervous! Two years later, when we were re-evaluated Stanley was my evaluator! It was wonderful having a person who not only knew me and Sunny, but knew our breed so well.

He was a wonderful man on so many levels. I will miss his presence very much."

Dear Denver Samoyed Rescue,

I promised to send Deb an update on Yeti and thought everyone would be interested. He is better than we expected. He has the sweetest temperament, he plays with the kids and is gentle with his play, he only barks when he feels we are not moving fast enough preparing his meals and then he will only give us one or two barks, he willingly uses his kennel, he does not chew on things in the house, he patiently waits to go outside, ...

Yeti has had training. It only took one walk to establish that he should not pull with his nearly 100 pounds of bulk. He now walks in an almost perfect healing position and needs only gentle reminders to stay there. He knows sit, down, beg, and shake. It is obvious he learned all these things with a quick treat reward because he will sit for less than a second then is up and ready for a treat. We are working on the sit/stay and down/stay and I am also practicing with him sitting when I stop during our walks. We have a

I thought you would enjoy a quick update on our wonderful Rosie. Rosie seemed to have no trouble adjusting to our family and guickly made herself at home. She has an absolutely sweet personality, is very well behaved and tolerates anything and everything (she came into our household when our Newfoundland was a 3-month old puppy and has endured all stages of Gracie growing up; now a 110 lb. puppy). Rosie has managed to lose 10 lbs so far (about 10-15 lbs to go) with daily walks of 2 to 3 miles and a better diet. Losing weight has been a big struggle for Rosie since she isn't a very active dog, but now that the cold weather has arrived and she is in her element out in the snow and cold, she has become much more active. We take her up to our place in Allenspark on the weekends and she actually jogs, sprints, and races around in the snow (and wears us out).


