September 16, 2013 - Membership Meeting Minutes

August Minutes were approved.

President - Sue Wangerin - The meeting was called to order by Sue - no report.

Vice President – Andi Mast – not present.

Recording Secretary, Chris Stewart - no report.

Corresponding Secretary, Martha Lageschulte - not present.

Treasurer, Thalia Peletis – General Fund: \$13,316.04 Rescue Fund: \$14,902.43 Grocery Cards: \$5,350.00 Total Assets: \$33,568.47

Grocery Card Profit to Date: \$2,007.50

Agility Trial, Marnie Grube – all the fees have been paid.

Awards, Mary Lloyd urged everyone to keep track of awards. The deadline for submissions to Mary will be Dec 2nd. Awards will be presented at the Holiday Party.

Working, Mary Lloyd - no report.

Historian/Librarian, Donna Dannen – no report.

Local Specialty reports:

Show Chairman, Heidi Neiman – The Premium list states there will be no online entries. Helen has addresses of the Club members and the participants from last year. Liz Swearingen can be contacted for other area addresses.

Trophies, Scooter - We are trying to collect some money that has been donated which is about \$300. Saturday's trophies

are covered. We need more donations for Sunday's show. Thalia made the comment that since the trophies are being covered by donations that maybe the Club should pay for the Holiday party. Lori mentioned that the cost is much higher than before. In the past the cost for the Holiday Party was about \$15 per person. This year it is \$25 per person. Chris made the suggestion that maybe the Club could pay \$15 of the cost and the members pay the other \$10. Nothing was decided on this. The Members will pay for Mexican dinner at the Specialty in November.

Hospitality, Marnie – We will be getting the sandwiches from Sprouts.

Photographer, Donna – In the contract for the Photographer, Kurt Fehlhauer will be the only one there. We will have expenses for one person including the hotel, dinner for Saturday night, and lunch. There is a problem with the backdrop being made of paper. Donna will check on a vinyl backdrop. The stand is a problem because of cost. Terry has the dog podium. Jan said the trailer has a stand. The pictures will be posted on-line on Smug Mug and will be available for purchase within a week of the Show. A digital copy will be available for \$25. Signs for the photographer are being made.

Rosettes, Lori - Will be a Neck Sash for Major wins. Party favors will be provided for all exhibitors. It was discussed that if any trophy donations are missing then we can use Andi Mast's idea for gift certificate for Club merchandise or future entries.

Programs, Mary Lloyd – nothing to report.

Rescue, Thalia - all dogs have been adopted. Thalia introduced the new Fund Raiser, Bling grooming nooses in many different colors for \$20 each. They were a big hit at the meeting and several were purchased already. They will be at the National Specialty, but DSA members will have first choice before the National Specialty. There will be 200 available and profits will go to Rescue.
