

437 Samoyeds have been helped by DSR during 1993 - 2017

This past year included a number of challenges starting with the passing of Andi Mast, our chairperson. Thankfully all the volunteers of the DSR committee stepped up and helped where needed; Pam Arnold, Deb Castro, Liz Evans, Thalia Peletis, Michele Sottile, and Sue Wangerin.

In January we received 2 male dogs in rescue, Simi and Ollie. Simi was a Sam/Sib mix and had issues with small dogs. Thank you to Pam Arnold for fostering him as we learned more about his personality. Simi was placed with a young couple who agreed to take Ollie to obedience training. They successfully completed the course and the best news came when we received a FB photo of this couple and Simi with his Wolfpack on at the top of a mountain as Simi witness the couple becoming engaged.

Thank you to **Sydney Langner** for transporting Ollie from Delta, CO who turned out to not only be severely un-

derweight but also has an auto immune skin disease, sebaceous adenines (SA). A big thank you to Liz Evans who fostered Ollie for 6 months until she realized she and Ollie were very bonded to each other so she adopted him in June. Thanks to Rachael Paulson for the numerous very messy oil baths that changed Ollie from pretty much a brown hairless dog to white fluffy one looking like a true Samoyed. Thanks also to Deb Castro for being the veterinary contact at VRCC for all of Ollie's medical needs, and there were many.

Our third dog was a female who came to us from Bozeman, MT. She was being fostered by a lady that had previously adopted from us. Gogi had a fracture in her foot from an old injury which caused her to limp. After numerous applications were reviewed by the foster mom and no suitable family for Gogi was found in Montana or surrounding states the foster mom transported her to Denver. Gogi (name changed to Abby) was adopted by a family that had an application on file with DSR. This family came to the February 2017 shows and met several people from DSA. Seven months later they were willing to adopt Abby who arrived with a cast on her foot after surgery for the old fracture.

Although DSR for the past several years has placed fewer than 4 or 5 dogs per year, the Colorado Department of Agriculture required us to become licensed by the Pet Animal Care Facilities Act (PACFA) and pay a

\$225 annual license fee. This requirement was a result of the many rescue groups known as 'retail rescue' who were bringing in dogs from out-of-state and selling them for a profit. The State started receiving complaints about these groups from adopters because some of the dogs were ill, diseased, and not the breed the adopter was told they would get. Unfortunately, this resulted in small rescue groups like DSR to become licensed and adhere to the guidelines of PACFA.

Even though we only rescued 3 dogs this past year, DSR incurred expenses involving the medical care, transportation, and training of these dogs. We would not be able to function without the benefit of our fundraisers and unsolicited donations. Thank you to all the folks that help with selling the rescue products; leashes, collars, backpacks, hike systems, grooming loops, etc. A special thanks to all the gals that make the grooming loops, a labor of love. Also, we are grateful to the rescue families and friends of rescue who year-after-year make donations to DSR. We appreciate and honor these people.

And last thank you to the breeders who, we believe are part of the reason why our rescue numbers are low, are doing a great job of placing their puppies and staying in touch with the families throughout the life of the dog.

 regional clubs for their specialties.
- Discuss the possibility and interest in DSA and friends hosting the 2021 Samoyed Club of America National Specialty. DSA host a local stand alone specialty, and we are quite successful based on feedback from exhibitors. As we've learned, it takes a village (DSA Club members) to put our Specialty on every year, and the task of hosting a National Specialty will require contributions for all our members to make it a successful show.
- Finalize / Fill 2018 Committee Chair positions.
