I am pleased to announce that the Samoyed Club of America Education and Research Foundation will have all-occasion greeting cards for sale. Part of the Foundation's charter is 'Education' and that was kept in mind when determining the pricing for the cards. The black and white cards are numbered 1 through 40 and will be for sale with 8 in a box for \$12.00 plus sales tax. All profits will go to the SCA Foundation. I thank all of the SCA members who provided all of the original photos of their past Sams for this project. Because of the scanning, proofing, and editing involved, we are not able to offer the complete lineup of almost 80 dogs at this time. There are 5 sets altogether (8 cards in a set) that have been printed up and the cards were packed by Speedy Litho of Longview, Washington--the same printer that is currently working on the SCA invoices that will go out November 1, 2005.

I think you will like the cards and will find them useful as convenient thank-you notes, holiday greetings, or trophies at Samoyed Specialties. A Sammy appears on the cover (40 different) and there is a brief writeup on each dog on the back side. The inside of each card is blank to be filled in by the sender. Some folks may decide to frame the card or frame a series of cards together.

Anyone making a donation to the SCA Foundation will receive a numbered Samoyed card along with an acknowledgement card. I regret I couldn't use all of the pictures provided but I did use at least one

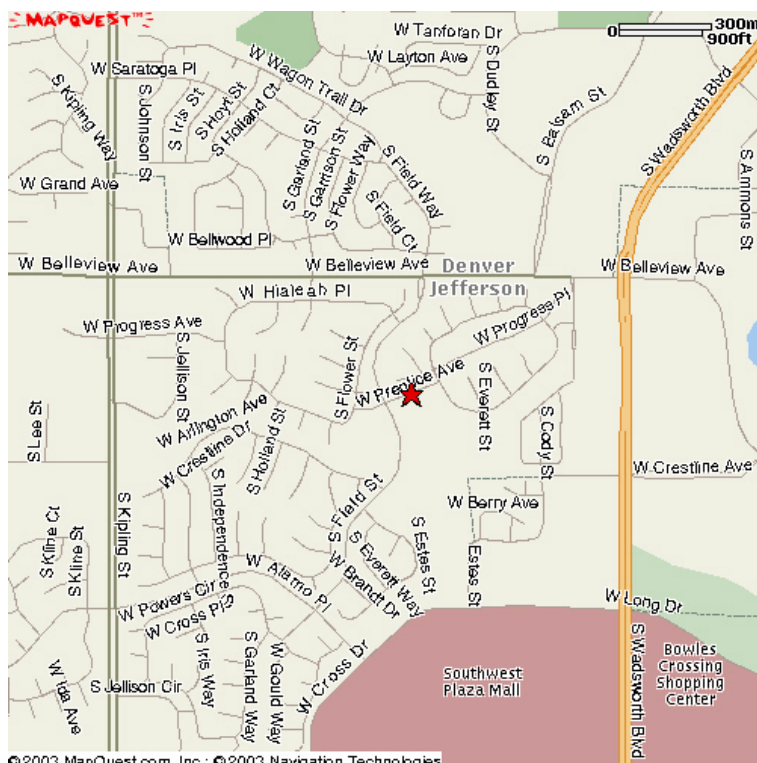

Grocery Certificate Fundraiser How Does it Work?

DSA purchases grocery certificates in bulk from King Soopers and Safeway at a discounted price. The amount of the discount is dependent on the amount of certificates purchased at once.

\$ Amount	Discount
<\$2,500	3%
\$2,500 <\$5,000	4%
\$5,000 & over	5%

DSA sells the certificates at their face value. A \$25 certificate is sold for \$25, and the purchaser can use it to buy \$25 worth of groceries. So, basically it's just like cash for the buyer, but DSA benefits from it!

For King Soopers, the certificates come in \$25 amounts, and you will receive cash back if the purchase amount is less than the certificate amount. King Soopers certificates are also accepted at Albertsons grocers.

For Safeway, the certificates are gift cards, and come in \$50 and \$100 amounts. If your bill is less than the gift card amount, then the balance remains on the gift card, instead of receiving cash back.

Last year DSA earned over \$2,600, and the money served to fund many club activities that you enjoy and the necessary administrative costs (tax prep fees, liability insurance, etc.) that keeps the club running.

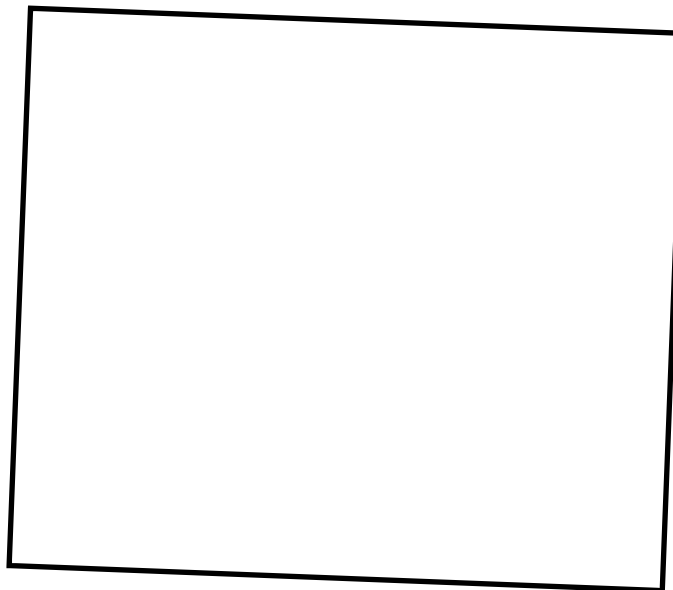
